**TODAY'S READINGS**

**First Reading** – Isaiah is called to be a messenger for the Lord and responds, "Send me!"

(Isaiah 6:1-2a, 3-8)

**Psalms** – In the sight of the angels I will sing your praises, Lord (Psalm 138).

**Second Reading** – Paul reminds us of the gospel he preached through which we are saved, if we believe it (1 Corinthians 15:1-11 [3-8, 11]).

**Gospel** – Jesus directs Simon to take his boat into deep water for a miraculous catch of fish.

(Luke 5:1-11).

**SUNDAY'S MUSIC**

The melody of the **Call to Worship** was arranged from a set of popular variations for piano and first appeared in hymnals in 1889: *Come, Christians, join to sing, Alleluia, Amen. Loud praise to Christ our King, Alleluia, Amen. Let all with heart and voice, before his throne rejoice, Praise is his gracious choice, Alleluia, Amen.*

The text of the **Offertory** is set to one of Johann Sebastian Bach's melodies which originally appeared in one of two volumes titled *Note-Book for Anna Magdalena Bach*, his second wife, dating from 1722 and 1725. The first contains works only by Bach, while the second is a compilation of music by him and other composers of the era, providing a nearly unparalleled glimpse into domestic music of the 18th century, doubtless in use on long winter evenings when the clock ticked slowly and his family members sought to create their own entertainment. The text is from Psalm 86: *Bow down your ear, O Lord, and hear me, preserve my soul and save me, Lord, I have trusted in you. Bow down your ear, O Lord, and hear me, my heart will glorify you, turn your face unto me.*

The **Communion** begins with a motet by William Byrd (1543-1623) of which the five-line text attributed to Pope Innocent VI covers the Incarnation, the Passion, the Eucharist and the Last Judgment. During the Middle Ages it was sung at the elevation: *Hail true body: that was born of the Virgin Mary, that truly suffered and was sacrificed on the Cross for men, from whose pierced side flowed water and blood; be for us a foretaste of death and judgment. O sweet and gentle Jesus! Son of Mary.*

The **second piece** is by Sir Charles Hubert Hastings Parry, (1848-1918), who reluctantly began his working life after Oxford as an underwriter at Lloyd's of London to satisfy the wishes of his father and his prospective in-laws. He concurrently continued his music studies to become as successful in music as he had been unsuccessful in insurance, and as his works came to the attention of the public, musical commissions started to pour in, firmly establishing his second career. The evocative text is: *Dear Lord and Father of mankind, forgive our foolish ways; reclothe us in our rightful mind, in purer lives thy service find, in deeper reverence praise. In simple trust, like theirs who heard beside the Syrian sea, the gracious calling of the Lord; let us, like them without a word, rise up and follow thee. Drop thy still dews of quietness, till all our strivings cease; take from our souls the strain and stress, and let our ordered lives confess the beauty of thy peace. Breathe through the heats of our desire, thy coolness and thy balm; let sense be dumb, let flesh retire, speak through the earthquake, wind, and fire, O still small voice of calm!*

The **third piece** is a benediction written by John Rutter for his alma mater, Clare College, Cambridge: *May the Lord show his mercy upon you, may the light of his presence be your guide, may he guard you and uphold you, may his spirit be ever by your side. When you sleep, may his angels watch over you, when you wake, may he fill you with his grace. May you love him and serve him all your days, then in heaven may you see his face.*
